The Auckland Road Maintenance Alliance – West (ARMA – West) is responsible for delivering the operational and renewal requirements for a third of Auckland’s roads, including the central business district.

The five-year, \$225 million contract is the first maintenance alliance contract to be awarded in New Zealand. The contract area, which includes the CBD, stretches from Dominion Road to the western boundary of Auckland City.

ARMA – West comprises client Auckland City Council, Leighton Contractors, MWH New Zealand, and Blacktop Construction Limited.

The Alliance is responsible for achieving all the contract’s objectives such as high road construction standards, road signage,

pavement design, stakeholder communication, safety improvements and improving the condition of the overall network in a short a period as possible.
