## Hale Street Link

The Hale Street Link project is part of Brisbane City Council's TransApex program of network initiatives. The bridge is currently being built under an Alliance (Council, Bouygues Travaux

Publics, Seymour Whyte, Hyder Consulting, and MacMahon Contractors Limited) and is due for completion by mid 2010.

The Hale Street Link is a tolled, four-lane cross-river bridge connecting Coronation Drive and Hale Street in Milton, to Montague Road, Merivale and Cordelia Streets in South Brisbane.

## Hale Street Link Tolling Revenue Collection Service

Hale Street Link Tolling Infrastructure contract involves the installation of a fully electronic, free flowing tolling system.

Leighton Contractors Pty Limited has been chosen by the Brisbane City Council to lead a consortium to design, construct, operate and maintain the Hale Street Link Tolling Revenue Collection Service project.

Leighton Contractors will partner with the RiverCity Motorway Group and Kapsch TrafficCom AB to deliver this complex tolling services contract, drawing on its extensive toll road experience and a track record of managing a diverse range of project interfaces.

The Bridge is scheduled for completion in 2010 and is forecast to carry approximately 22,100 vehicles per day by 2021. Once complete, Leighton Contractors will operate and maintain the tolling system on behalf of Brisbane City Council.
