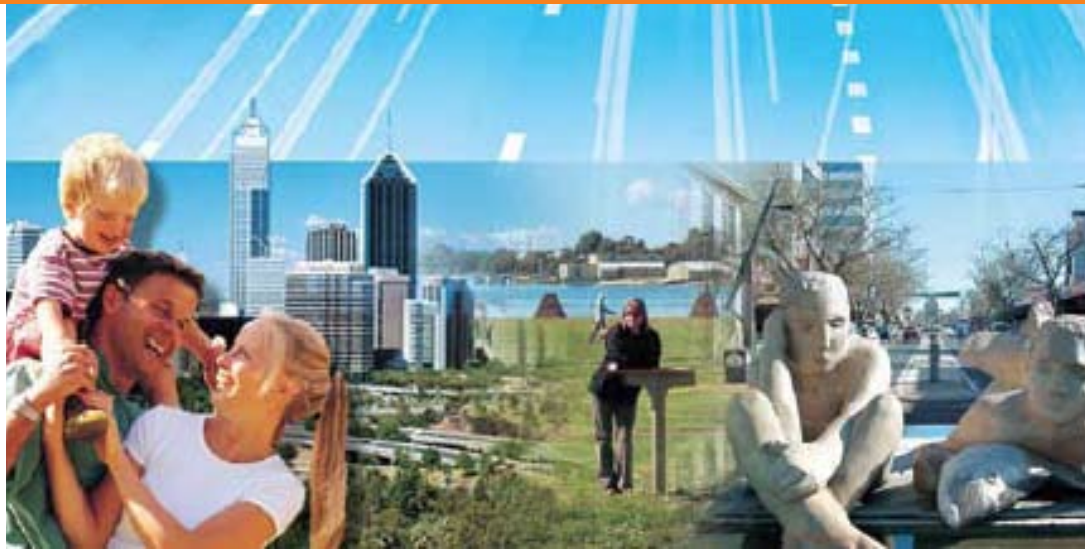


# New Perth Bunbury Highway

Alliance to design and construct a 70 km connection between communities in perth and bunbury.

When completed, the new road will reduce travel time by up to 35 minutes. After a long selection process, the Southern Gateway Alliance (Leighton Contractors, GHD, WA Limestone) was formed. Despite an 8 month delay, 90% of the proposed key personnel are committed to the project.

Community considerations play a major role in the project's processes. Liaison and consultation are key activities in the planning and implementation phases.

This is one of the first projects to formally embrace sustainability. Specialists have joined the team in developing a "Framework for Sustainability". The hope is that this will form a model for future construction projects in the State.
